Seasonal unit rates

With low unit rates for the autumn and winter months, our tariff will help you to manage your bills during higher usage seasons.



No standing charge

We've removed the standing charge from October - March to help you pay even less when your pump is in use.



Direct Debit only

Pay by variable Direct Debit, helping you to stay on top of your monthly energy use.



Monthly billing

Your first payment is taken on your supply start date, with payments taken on the same day of each month after that.



Heating for a cleaner, greener future

Over the past two decades, electricity generation in the UK has been transformed, with just under 40% of our electricity demand met by renewable sources. To reach net zero carbon emissions by 2050, we must also stop using fossil fuels for heating.

Currently 90% of UK homes are connected to the gas grid, with gas boilers responsible for one third of all household carbon emissions.

One way we can cut emissions is to stop heat escaping through draughty windows, floors and lofts. Most of our homes are energy inefficient and making home improvements can have a real impact on people's bills and carbon footprint.

Another way to tackle the problem is to replace gas boilers with renewable alternatives, including air and ground source heat pumps.

Supporting the Green Homes Grant

At Good Energy, we're committed to enabling people to help tackle the climate crisis by making the most of clean technologies.

With the Government launching the Green Homes Grant in autumn 2020, our heat pump tariff will do even more to help make green heating technology more affordable.
